Course Parameter Mapping for Creating, Updating Courses

Degreed Parameter	Description	NovoEd Course Attribute, Notes
title	The title of the course	Course Title (Course Basics)
external-id	The external ID of the course	Catalog-ID (Course Basics)
summary	Summary of the course	Course Description (Course Flyer/Intro page)
url	URL location where more information can be found.	URL to Course Flyer/Intro page
image-url	Cover image of the course	Cover Picture (Course Basics)
language	Spoken language of the course	Course Default Language
duration	Length of the course. Type is supplied with duration-type	Estimated Duration of course This can be found in the "Additional Metadata" section on Course Basics
duration-type	Seconds, Minutes, Hours, or Days	Duration type - Days or Hours
format	Format of the course, e.g. Classroom or Online	Automatically set and always sent "Online"
video-url	If the course has a video, supply it here	Course Promo Video URL (Flyer/Info page)



When is a Course Synced to Degreed?

Past courses from the institution are automatically synced to Degreed and utilizes multiple Degreed API “Content: Courses” endpoints (listed below).

Past data transfer speed is dependent on the amount of data being updated.

Course sync requirements are as follows: Released, Not closed, Non-demo course, and With one of the following Registration types: Free and Open to the Public, Open within Institution, Closed Enrollment (Only if integration configured to include closed enrollment courses (private)).

What does marking a course “obsolete” in Degreed mean in NovoEd?

When the course is closed on NovoEd, it means that no one can engage with the course. It will be marked obsolete on Degreed, and vice-versa.
